**Position Summary:** The Clinical Support Specialist will work collaboratively and under the direction of a licensed behavioral health clinician, along with person supported teams to support the development and implementation of behavioral support plans and data collection. The Clinical Support Specialist will focus on providing training on behavioral supports which is conducted in person with person supported and staff. This job requires staff to work in-person and onsite in the community.

### **Education, Training and Experience:**

- Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Social Work or Applied Behavioral Analysis required
- Must be one of the following or obtain within 90 days of employment: Certified Crisis Intervention Specialist, Certified Behavioral Intervention Technician, or Registered Behavioral Technician.
- 2-3 years of experience in a human services field; DDA experience preferred.
- Experience in taking support and behavioral skills and incorporating them in a multiple disciplinary approach.
- Fluent in Microsoft Office Suite (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Outlook, etc.)

### **Other Requirements:**

- Access to reliable transportation. This job requires travel in the community.
- Active valid driver's license and driving record that has no more than two (2) points.
- Maintenance of all required trainings under DDA guidelines and The Arc NCR policies and procedures
- Flexibility of scheduling to meet program needs; including but not limited to, on-call nights and weekends.
