As the **Assistant Director of Children, Youth & Their Families**, you will develop and implement a wide range of services for children and youth with a focus on a multigenerational approach to services. This role is responsible for leading family navigation, Project Learn, and DDA-approved children services in ways that engage internal and external stakeholders to find innovative, person-centered approaches to serve children and youth with disabilities and their families.

The Assistant Director will enhance existing family engagement and navigation strategies in Anne Arundel County and in partnership with the Family Navigator focused on the Eastern Shore. Supporting the development of new programs and ensuring compliance with all regulatory, licensing, and accreditation requirements is a must. The ideal candidate will be able to remain flexible, calm under pressure, and adaptive to change as priorities shift. The ability to work autonomously in ambiguous situations and work across cultural, geographic, and programmatic lines are essential.

This position requires a bachelor's degree in social work, education, or a related field along with five years of progressive leadership experience facilitating and managing programs for children with IDD and/or mental health issues, though a master's degree in social work and an active LCSW Maryland license are preferred along with experience providing holistic, multi-generational services. The salary is \$68,250/annually and comes with a competitive benefits package.
